(1) SFU reports non-Science rather than Arts alone. UBC reports all new entry to Arts and Science together with direct entries from secondary school.

(2) There are some transfers with partial Year 1 from B.C. colleges to Year 1 at the universities. They are generally assessed on the basis of their B.C. secondary school marks and are in the Direct Entry quota if they graduated within the previous year and satisfy the minimum secondary school cut-off. Otherwise they may appear in another category (B.C. College or Other) depending on whether or not additional courses have been taken. The numbers reported are minimums for UBC.

(3) Quotas for SFU and UVic are not differentiated between Years 2 and 3. They include some transfers to Year 4 at UBC. The numbers for UBC are minimums. Graduates from the college Associate in Arts/Science program are admitted with a GPA of 2.00 at SFU.

(4) This group of new students may include: additional B.C. college students (UBC), mature students, students from other provinces, countries, faculties, students from technical colleges and visiting students. The cut-off points vary by group and by year level and are as high or higher than those for the comparable direct entry students from the B.C. secondary schools or colleges. For RRU, this group may include students from outside BC, University graduates, and those advanced standing for prior learning through non-traditional means. There is no standard cut-off point but the learners are expected to process the same skill levels as those for the comparable entry from BC Colleges.

(5) UNBC set no enrolment quotas from Fall 1997 to Fall 2005.

(6) Starting in Fall 1999, UVIC Arts includes the Faculties of Humanities and Social Science.

(7) In Fall 2001, the actual number of UBC students admitted dramatically exceeded the quota. The over enrolment (actual minus planned) is as follows:

Arts -- direct entry (+380), transfer to year 2 (+212), transfer to year 3 (+142).

Science -- direct entry (+230), transfer to year 2 (+23), transfer to year 3 (+11).

(8) Starting in 2003, SFU "Direct Entry" and "Transfers" exclude international student counts. International student counts included with "Other Students".
